

We, the Muslim Community of Central Pennsylvania cordially invite you to the symposium "United We Stand against Hate & Bigotry," a discussion lead by Dr. Yasir Qadhi, on Sunday, March 6th, 2016.

We are all aware of the global geopolitical realities & war that has claimed so many lives and raised so much fear. This is a complicated issue with competing factions of extremism and reactionary Islamophobia. Dr. Qadhi will address these complex issues from the context of American Muslims, a community committed to their American Identity with shared concerns and fears.

Dr. Qadhi, in addition to a chemical engineering background, holds a PhD in Religious Studies from Yale University & Masters of Islamic Theology from the College of Dawah (Madinah, Saudi Arabia). He is a well-respected scholar who has preached against both extremism and Islamophobia.
