




### How does the United States prison population compare with other countries?




With only 5 percent of the world's population, the United States holds 25 percent of the world's prisoners.




#### Prisoners Per 100,000 Population










#### **Incarceration Rates Especially High in South and Midwest**

## How does race, gender, socio-economic status and other social factors influence a person's chance of entering the criminal justice system?




- The number of youth in juvenile commitment has fallen by half since 2000.
- Racial disparities in youth commitment remain large and prevalent.
- One in three juvenile facilities has closed since 2002, with the highest rate of closure for large facilities.

The Sentencing Project **Declines in Youth Commitments and Facilities in the 21st Century,** 2015

- More than 60% of the people in prison are now racial and ethnic minorities.
- For Black males in their thirties, 1 in every 10 is in prison or jail on any given day.
- These trends have been intensified by the disproportionate impact of the "war on drugs," in which two-thirds of all persons in prison for drug offenses are people of color.


#### Lifetime Likelihood of Imprisonment


Do higher rates of crime within marginalized communities explain their higher rates of incarceration?

# The use of police discretion can unintentionally be influenced by racial bias.


### **Economic Factors**



Key segments of the criminal justice system are under funded, putting minorities - who are disproportionally low income – at a disadvantage.

Criminal justice policies exacerbate socioeconomic inequalities by imposing collateral consequences on those with criminal records.
